HISTORY, A VIEW, PLUS GREAT FOOD AND DRINK

Those planning a visit to the Riverland can enjoy an insight into local history at one of the region's most popular hotels.

Situated on the banks of the beautiful Murray River, the Swan Reach Hotel boasts quality meals and that good, old-fashioned country hospitality in a breath-taking setting.

Located just a 90-minute drive from Adelaide, Swan Reach is a popular destination for holiday makers, especially during the summer months.

The Swan Reach Hotel is unique in hotel standards, as it was not purpose built, but was formed around the original Swan Reach Homestead, built circa 1865.

Over its years of operation, the hotel has undergone several major transformations including the addition of the stone oneroom public bar in 1907 and the second story in 1912. In 1996, in order to make the most of the exquisite views, a new dining room was built directly overlooking the river.

Today, the Swan Reach Hotel has a walk-in bottle shop, a welcoming, traditional style Front

Bar including TAB facilities, a small Saloon Bar area with great river views, gaming room, eightball and games room, main Bistro area with sensational river views and upstairs, modest country hotel accommodation.



The Riverland offers a number of attractions that highlight the region's farming and irrigation history.

Olivewood Historic Homestead and Museum stands as a significant historical attraction, offering insights into Australia's pioneering irrigation and agricultural history. Constructed in 1889 for Charles Chaffey, a Canadian who, alongside

his brothers, established the Renmark and Mildura irrigation colonies, the homestead is a testament to early settlement efforts in the region.

The homestead is set amid expansive grounds, enhancing its historical charm. Inside, visitors can explore period furnishings and artefacts that reflect the 19th-century lifestyle of the Chaffey family.

With its well-preserved exhibits, Olivewood Historic Homestead and Museum provides a comprehensive

The village also hosts Alive Days, where volunteers demonstrate traditional crafts and activities, enhancing the educational experience. Recognised for its commitment to preserving local history, the Loxton Historical Village serves as a valuable resource for understanding the region's agricultural and social heritage.

Historical Village offers a vivid glimpse into rural life from the late 19th to mid-20th century. Established in 1970, the village features more than 45 fully furnished buildings, including a school, bank, blacksmith, and general store, each showcasing authentic artefacts and








4 DINNER AND A CRUISE?






